

# ORDINANCE No. 121714

An Ordinance officially naming as Errol Heights Park, certain property located at S.E. 52nd Avenue and Tenino Court, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that two parcels of land were acquired by the City at S.E. 52nd Avenue and Tenino Court as park property by annexation; that prior to annexation the property was maintained by Multnomah County as park property and after annexation the County conveyed title to the City and after annexation the County conveyed title to the City for public use (Ordinance No. 121105); that the Superintendent in charge of the Bureau of Parks has recommended that the official name for this park property be Errol Heights Park and the Commissioner in charge of the Bureau of Parks has an accommendation in the Commissioner in charge of the Bureau of Parks has an accommendation in the Commissioner in c
