Subject Request for Ordinance Officially Naming
Errol Heights Park

December 8, 1965

Dear Commissioner Bean:

Please have ordinance prepared officially naming Errol Heights Park, certain property located at S. E. 52nd Avenue and Tenino Court.

This property was acquired by the City by Ordinance No. 121105, accepting a deed from Multnomah County to two parcels of land located at S. E. 52nd Avenue and Tenino Court for public purposes.

This property has been maintained by the County as park area and, as the area is now within City limits as a result of annexation, the County has conveyed title to the City for public use.

Superintendent of Parks Harry Buckley has decided on the name of Errol Heights Park, naming it after the subdivision in which this piece of property is located.

A map, quarter section #3835, is attached, along with copy of Ordinance No. 121105.

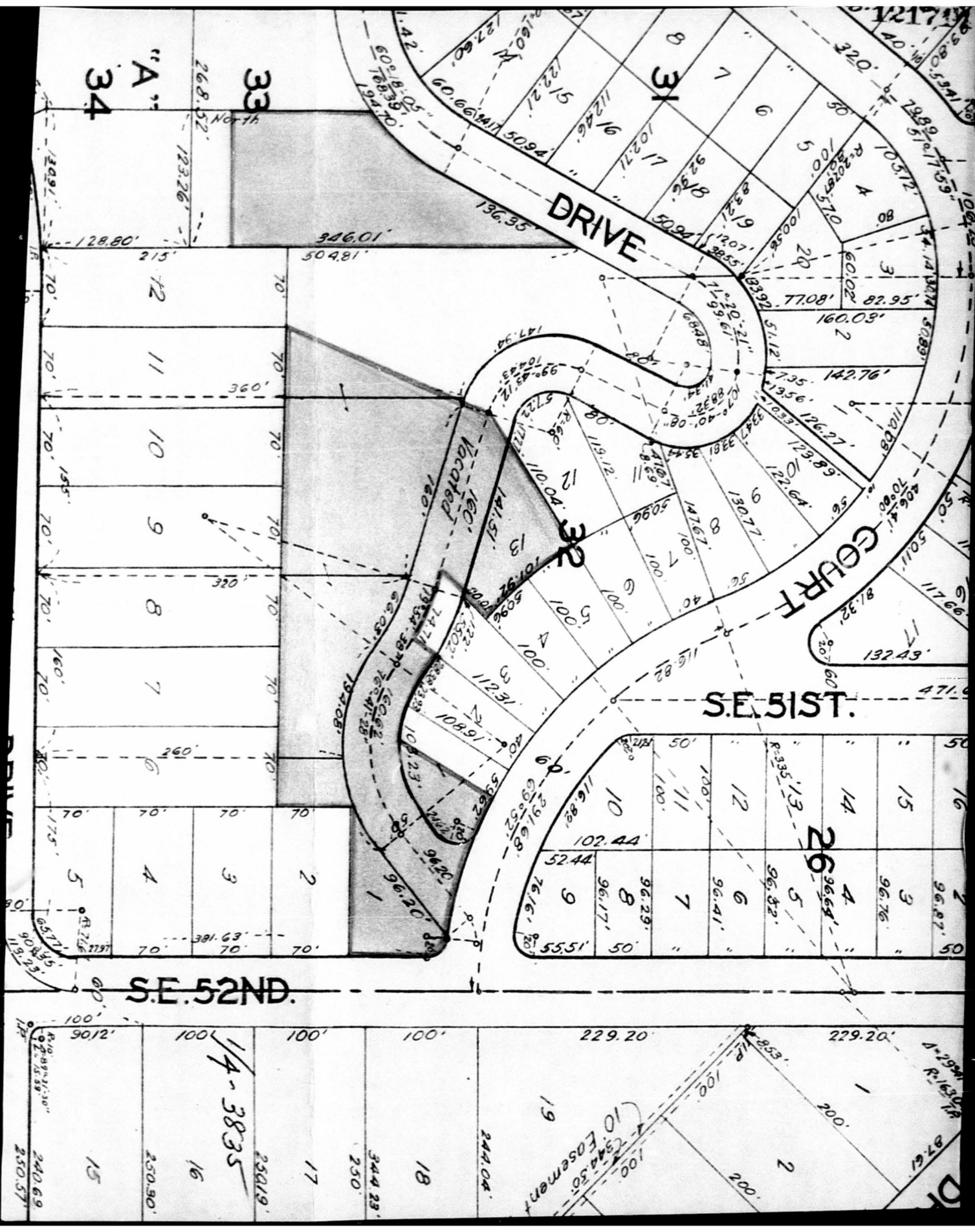

ORDINANCE No. 121714


An Ordinance officially naming as Errol Heights Park, certain property located at S.E. 52nd Avenue and Tenino Court, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:


Section 1. The Council finds that two parcels of land were acquired by the City at S.E. 52nd Avenue and Tenino Court as park property by annexation; that prior to annexation the property was maintained by Multnomah County as park property and after annexation the County conveyed title to the City for public use (Ordinance No. 121105); that the Superintendent in charge of the Bureau of Parks has recommended that the official name for this park property be Errol Heights Park and the Commissioner in charge of the Bureau of Parks has approved said recommendation; now, therefore, the park property acquired by the City of Portland through annexation and conveyance from Multnomah County and located at S.E. 52nd Avenue and Tenino Court shall be and the same hereby is officially named Errol Heights Park.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that the official name of the property referred to in Section 1 hereof may be made a matter of record without delay, therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
