## ORDINANCE NO. 129304

An ordinance permitting V W R United Corporation to discharge certain effluents into City sewers under the regulations of Article 10 of the Portland Public Works Code and in accordance with certain terms and conditions, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that Ordinance No. 122601, passed by the Council June 2, 1966, permitted United Pacific Corporation to discharge certain effluents into the City sewer for a charge and waived certain requirements of the Public Works Code upon certain conditions; that the V W R United Corporation, 1600 Norton Building, Seattle, Washington 98103, successor to United Pacific Corporation, was granted a permit for one year from April 25, 1968, by Ordinance No. 126686; that V W R United Corporation has requested an extension of that permit and the City Engineer has recommended that the request be allowed with certain provisions of the agreement deleted due to broader provisions of the Public Works Code as revised effective April 21, 1969, and the Commissioner of Public Works has approved the same; now, therefore, V W R United Corporation(hereinafter called Permittee) hereby is given the right to discharge process waste water from its new plant located at Centennial Mills, 1464 NW Front Avenue, into City sewers notwithstanding the provisions of Section 5-1013, Subsections (a)1, and (a)2, pertaining to B.O.D. and suspended solids, on the following terms and conditions:

- (a) Permittee agrees at its own expense to install, operate, maintain and improve and replace as needed all sewer facilities and all appurtenances needed to effectively and efficiently convey process waste water within and from said plant at 1464 NW Front Avenue to the City's sewer; that such facilities and sewer line shall be constructed in accordance with the application, specifications and plans submitted by Permittee and approved by the City Engineer, the Engineer-Manager of the Bureau of Sewage and Refuse Disposal of the City and the Oregon State Sanitary Authority. No such facility or service shall be installed or used until such approval has been had. Said company shall revise plans and specifications to meet requirements if requested either by the City Engineer or the Oregon State Sanitary Authority.
- (b) Permittee shall pay to the City, in addition to its regular monthly sewer user service charge as set forth under Article 11, Public Works Code of the City of Portland, the

charges set forth in Article 10 of the Code as revised effective April 21, 1969. Permittee shall also pay the cost of maintaining the City sewer in NW 9th Avenue from the point of Permittee's discharge to the manhole in NW Irving Street to the extent the same is attributable to Permittee's discharge or waste as determined by the City Engineer, which determination shall be final.

Permittee shall furnish a sampling device and provide daily samples of the effluent to the City upon which the Department of Public Works will determine the charges for billing in accordance with Article 10 of the Public Works Code.

- (c) The authority herein granted Permittee to discharge process waste water into City's sewers as set forth herein shall terminate on the expiration of five years from the date of the passage of this ordinance, or at any time prior thereto on written notice by the City to permittee.
- (d) That the permission hereby granted to Permittee is personal to said Permittee and does not run with the land, nor may the same be transferred, assigned or otherwise disposed of by said Permittee.
- (e) The permission provided by this ordinance shall not become effective until the Permittee shall have filed with the City Auditor in form approved by the City Attorney a document in accepting the terms and conditions of this ordinance.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that there may be no delay in providing authority contained in Section 1 hereof; therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
