

ORDINANCE NO. 132294

An Ordinance accepting certain gifts, authorizing the City Auditor to enter certain fountains, monuments, plaques, and statues on inventory, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that certain items, all gifts to the city, have never been formally accepted by the Council; and that all gifts should be kept on record as inventoried by the City Auditor; now, therefore, the following items are hereby accepted:


and the City Auditor is authorized to enter the appropriate items on the inventory records kept on similar items.
