ORDINANCE NO.

An Ordinance authorizing continuance of negotiations for the purchase of a tract of land in the SE 1/4 of Section 22, T1S, R4E, W. M., Multnomah County, Oregon, authorizing the Portland Development Commission to commence condemnation proceedings for the acquisition thereof on behalf of the city if the property cannot be purchased, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that on February 14, 1974, the Council passed Ordinance No. 137837, authorizing an agreement between the Portland Development Commission subject to approval of City Council and the city wherein the Portland Development Commission was to provide real estate services for the city; that pursuant to this agreement the Portland Development Commission has been negotiating for the purchase of a tract of land, 57.10 acres in size, located in the SE 1/4 of Section 22, T1S, R4E, W. M., Multnomah County, Oregon, and owned by Mollers Nursery, Inc., an Oregon corporation, for a future water reservoir site for the Bureau of Water Works; that the Portland Development Commission has been unable to date to purchase said property and that it is presently necessary to authorize commencement of condemnation proceedings to acquire the property at the earliest possible date unless agreement for its purchase is first obtained; that the Council also finds that this acquisition is necessary for the public's benefit;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Portland Development Commission, by and through its attorneys, Williams, Montague, Stark, Hiefield & Norville, P.C., hereby is authorized and directed to file in the Circuit Court of Multnomah County, Oregon, a condemnation action for the acquisition of the following described real property, unless agreement for its purchase is first obtained, said property being described as follows:

The Southwest one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter; and the South one-half of the Northwest one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter of Section 22, Township 1 South, Range 4 East of the Willamette Meridian, in the County of Multnomah and State of Oregon; EXCEPTING therefrom that parcel conveyed to The Mount Hood Railway and Power Company, in deed recorded January 12, 1911 in Book 525, page 113; ALSO EXCEPTING therefrom the parcel conveyed to Multnomah Central Railway Company in deed recorded September 30, 1912 in Book 594, page 377; and SUBJECT to the rights of the public in and to that portion of the above property lying within the limits of Dodge Park Boulevard and Carpenter Lane.

ORDINANCE No.

That the Portland Development Commission is also hereby authorized to make a written offer to the property owners in an amount not exceeding the highest appraisal on the property.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that the city may acquire the property described in Section 1 hereof for use as a future water reservoir without undue delay; therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
