ORDINANCE NO. 143640

An Ordinance acknowledging the fulfillment of terms and conditions of Ordinance No. 139103, passed and effective November 14, 1974, which authorized the loan of the City of Portland's steam locomotive, No. SP-4449, and tender, No. SP-9101, to the American Freedom Train Foundation, Inc., terminating the American Freedom Train Foundation's obligations, providing for notice, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- (1) Ordinance No. 139103, passed and effective November 14, 1974, authorized the loan of the City of Portland's steam locomotive, No. SP-4449, and tender, No. SP-9101, to the American Freedom Train Foundation, subject to certain terms and conditions;
- (2) The engine and tender have been returned to the City of Portland and the American Freedom Train Foundation requests acknowledgment from the city that the terms and conditions of the ordinance granting the loan of the engine and tender have been fulfilled;
- (3) The Commissioner in charge advises and recommends that the American Freedom Train Foundation, Inc. has fulfilled all the terms and conditions and that Council approval and acknowledgment should be made;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- (a) The City of Portland hereby acknowledges to the American Freedom Train Foundation, Inc. that all terms and conditions of Ordinance No. 139103, passed and effective November 14, 1974, which authorized the loan of the City of Portland's steam engine, No. SP-4449, and its tender, No. SP-9101, have been fulfilled, and that said locomotive and tender have been returned to the City of Portland in an operable condition;
- (b) This acknowlgment is be effective as to all the terms and conditions of Ordinance No. 139103 excepting such claims or liabilities which may be unknown or which may hereafter be made under paragraph 5 of said ordinance (hold harmless agreement);

(c) The Auditor hereby is directed to provide the Foundation notification by mailing a certified copy of this ordinar e to the American Freedom Train Foundation, Inc., 52 5 Leesburg Pike, Suite 800, Bailey's Crossroads, Virginia 22041.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because it is necessary to give immediate acknowledgment to the American Freedom Train Foundation, Inc.; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
