ORDINANCE NO. 149969

An Ordinance authorizing the Bureau of Fire to grade and pave a portion of SW 5th Avenue lying north of and adjacent to SW Taylors Ferry Road to provide additional parking area in connection with a fire station proposed to be constructed on Lots 5 to 8, Block 32, Carson Heights, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

- The Bureau of Fire proposes to construct a fire station on Lots 5 to 8 inclusive, Block 32, Carson Heights.
- That SW 5th Avenue adjacent to the fire station site is unimproved and not needed for public street use other than as a location for underground utilities.
- That the Bureau of Fire has requested it be given authority to grade and pave the unimproved street area to provide parking for fire station personnel.
- 4. That the owner of property abutting the portion of street proposed to be paved does not object to the proposal on condition access to a door to an existing building is provided.
- 5. That the City Engineer and Commissioner of Public Works recommend the request of the Bureau of Fire be granted under certain conditions.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Bureau of Fire is authorized to grade, pave and maintain that portion of unimproved SW 5th Avenue lying between the northerly line of SW Taylors Ferry Road and the westerly extension of the north line of Lot 8, Block 32, Carson Heights, to provide a parking area for Fire Bureau personnel. The authorization herein granted is on condition access to the door of an existing building located on Lot 5, Block 30, Carson Heights, is provided and on the further condition grading plans shall be submitted to the City Engineer for his review and approval prior to commencement of any work in the street area.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because delay in passage of this ordinance could cause delay in finalizing plans for construction of a fire station; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
