

ORDINANCE No. 152887

An Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to call for bids to provide labor for the conversion of 3,500 mercury vapor street lights to high pressure sodium vapor street lights, authorizing a contract, authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Street Lighting Division requires labor to convert mercury vapor street lights to high pressure sodium vapor street lights.
2. The Council approves funding of the project described above, in Fiscal Year 1981-82.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Purchasing Agent shall advertise for bids using specifications filed in his office on February 4, 1982, and in the event that no satisfactory bid is received, shall readvertise on the same basic specifications until a satisfactory bid is received.
- b. The Commissioner of the Department of Public Works and the Auditor hereby are authorized to execute a contract with the responsible bidder for the project described in Section 1 hereof, in accordance with specifications filed with the Purchasing Agent on February 4, 1982.
- c. The Mayor and Auditor hereby are authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the 1981-82 Street Lighting Fund, Street Lighting Division, 33220022/Project 6043/240, when demanded and approved by the proper authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with the project may result in additional expense, and will unnecessarily deprive the City of the benefits of completion of the contract at an early date; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
