Ordinance No. 19939

An Ordinance adopting the report of the City Engineer in the matter of the proposed
Opening, laying out and establishing of Willamette
Boulevard ~~from~~
from the north line of Morris Street to the westerly line
of the City Boundary lying west of Willamette Boulevard
Acres

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1.

WHEREAS, The Council, of the City of Portland deeming it expedient to
open, lay out and establish Willamette Boulevard

~~from~~
from the north line of Morris Street to the westerly line of
the City Boundary lying west of Willamette Boulevard Acres

did, on the 29th day of July 1909, direct the City
Engineer to survey the same, and to mark the boundaries thereof, and to make a plat of
such survey, and a written report containing a full and perfect description of such pro-
posed Boulevard and the boundaries thereof and of the portion of each lot, tract,
or part of either to be appropriated for such street, and the City Engineer having made
such survey, plat and report and filed such plat and report in the office of the Auditor
of the City of Portland on the 18th day of August 1909
and the said plat and report being satisfactory to the Council is now hereby adopted,

TO THE HONORABLE MAYOR AND COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF PORTLAND.

Gentlemen:

In pursuance of a resolution adopted by your Honorable Body at your meeting of July 29th, 1909, directing me to survey and mark the boundaries of a proposed opening, laying out and establishing of Willamette Boulevard in the City of Portland, County of Multnomah, State of Oregon, as the same was made a County Road by Legislative Act of February 17th, 1899, by taking said Willamette Boulevard over within the corporate limits of the City of Portland from a County Road to a City street, I have surveyed and marked the boundaries of the proposed opening, ~~laying out and establishing~~ of Willamette Boulevard and herein submit my report together with a plat of said survey.

The proposed opening, laying out and establishing of Willamette Boulevard is a part of Willamette Boulevard established in 1891 from Albina to St Johns and extended from the north line of Morris Street to the westerly line of the City Boundary lying west of Willamette Boulevard Acres, the boundaries of same being more specifically shown on the accompanying map.

The proposed opening, laying out and establishing of Willamette Boulevard as above described, will include and necessitate the appropriation to public use as a City Street all that parcel or tract of land lying within the boundaries of the proposed opening, laying out and establishing of Willamette Boulevard as above described, now used and occupied as a County Road.
