Ordinance No 20629

An Ordinance authorizing the issuance and sale of Improvement Bonds in pursuance of an Act of the Legislature of the State of Oregon.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1: That in pursuance of applications of owners of property to pay certain assessments for the improvement of streets and the laying of sewers, in installments as provided by an Act of the Legislature of the State of Oregon, entitled: "An Act to provide for the issuance of bonds for the improvement of streets and laying of sewers in incorporated cities and for the payment of the cost of such improvement and laying of sewers by installments," filed in the office of the Secretary of State February 22nd, 1893, as amended by an Act entitled: "An Act to amend Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 of an Act entitled: 'An Act to provide for the issuance of bonds for the improvement of streets and laying of sewers in incorporated cities, and for the payment of the cost of such improvements and laying of sewers by installments,' approved February 28, 1901," and an Act entitled: "An Act to amend an Act entitled, 'An Act to incorporate the City of Portland, Multnomah County, State of Oregon, and to provide a Charter therefor, and to repeal all Acts or parts of Acts in conflict therewith,' filed in the office of the Secretary of State January 23, 1903, as amended, by inserting after Section 383 of said Charter, and before Section 384 of said Charter, a section to be known as Section 383-A of said Charter," adopted by a vote of the electors of the City of Portland at the general election held in said City on the 7th day of June, 1909, and proclaimed by the Mayor of said City on the 24th day of June, 1909, providing for the issuance of bonds for the improvement of streets and laying of sewers, and for the payment of the cost of such

Improvements and laying of sewers by installments, the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to execute the improvement bonds of the City of Portland in the sum of ~~Four Hundred Sixty-six~~ ~~Five Hundred Eleven~~ Dollars and twenty-four cents (\$496,511.24) and deliver the same to the purchaser thereof upon the payment of the purchase price to the City Treasurer of the City of Portland, applications of property owners to pay assessments in said sum having been made and filed as follows:

Each of said bonds to be dated January 1st, 1910 and to run for a period of ten years from date thereof, unless redemption of said bonds shall be made prior to said date as provided in said act, and said bonds shall bear interest from date thereof at the rate of six per cent (6%) per annum, payable semi-annually until redeemed, interest and principal payable at the office of the Treasurer of the City of Portland, Oregon, in gold coin of the United States.

Section 2: That the Committee on Ways and Means of the Council be and is hereby authorized to advertise for bids for said bonds and to sell for the highest price obtainable but not less than par, and accrued interest, the bonds to be issued as in this Ordinance provided.

Section 3: The treasurer of the City of Portland is hereby directed to credit the face value and accruing interest arising

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from the sale of bonds respectively to the Improvement Funds on account of which the same were issued, and to the Street and Sewer Interest Fund and whatever premium may be received shall be credited to the General Fund.

Section 4: Whereas there is an immediate necessity that this Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval by the Mayor, an emergency is hereby declared and said Ordinance is hereby declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, peace and safety of the people of the City of Portland for the following reasons: That certain proceedings for the improvement of streets and construction of sewers have been fully completed by the contractor and his work approved and accepted by the City Engineer, and the cost thereof not having been fully paid by the property owner benefited by said improvements, that said property owner having bonded the payment thereof, said contractor is justly entitled to payment for said work. Therefore this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its approval by the Mayor.
