

Ordinance No. 25642.....

An Ordinance authorizing the acquisition of certain property for Park and Boulevard purposes and declaring an emergency.

THE CITY OF PORTLAND DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Mayor of the City of Portland be and he is hereby authorized to purchase and acquire, upon such terms as he may deem proper, the following described real property to be used for park and boulevard purposes: Beginning at the southwest corner of Lot 1, in Block 20, Portland Homestead, Multnomah County, State of Oregon, running thence easterly along the south line of said lot 105.43^{feet} to a point; thence in a northwesterly direction 133.1 feet to a point in the west side of said lot 81.24 feet north of the place of beginning; thence south along the west side of said lot 81.24 feet to the place of beginning, in the corporate limits of the City of Portland, Oregon, owned by P. A. Cox, and, in the event that the Mayor should be unable to acquire said property by agreement with the owner the City Attorney of this City is hereby authorized and directed to institute and prosecute condemnation proceedings for the acquisition of said property.

Section 2: Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: that the title of the City to a large amount of other property is conditional upon the completion of the Hillside Parkway within a limited time and the acquisition of the property herein described, which property forms a part of said Hillside Parkway, therefore an emergency is hereby declared and this ordinance shall go into force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
