

Ordinance No. 26692.

An Ordinance accepting certain property for park and boulevard purposes.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the following described property be and is hereby accepted by the City of Portland for park and boulevard purposes:

Block numbered twenty (20), in Overlook, in County of Multnomah and State of Oregon.

That part of lot two (2), of subdivision four (4), of block fourteen (14), Portland Homestead, described as beginning at a point in the east line of said lot two (2) which is 86 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet south of the northeast corner of said lot two (2); thence south thirteen and one-half (13 $\frac{1}{2}$) feet to the southeast corner of said lot two (2); thence west ten and fifty-six hundredths (10.56) feet; thence on a curve to the left of 242 feet radius seventeen and nineteen hundredths (17.19) feet to the place of beginning.

Section 2. That the Auditor of the City of Portland be and is hereby directed to have the deeds to the property described in Section 1 of this ordinance placed on record: Provided, however, that said property shall not be accepted by the City until all liens against the same at the present time are discharged by the owners thereof within thirty days from the date of the approval of this ordinance.
