

An Ordinance to change and reestablish the curb lines on Willamette Boulevard.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1: That the curb lines on Willamette Boulevard be and the same are hereby changed and reestablished as follows:

The north and east curb line from the southwest corner of Block 2, Madrona Hill to the center line of Killingsworth Avenue, at 20 feet distant from and parallel to the north and east property line of said Willamette Boulevard;

The north and east curb line from the center line of Killingsworth Avenue to the center line of Wabash Avenue, at 15 feet distant from and parallel to the north and east property line of said Willamette Boulevard;

The north and east curb line from the center line of Wabash Avenue to the center line of Carey Boulevard, at 30 feet distant from and parallel to the north and east property line of said Willamette Boulevard;

The middle of 6-foot wearing surface of sidewalk on the north and east side of Willamette Boulevard from the center line of Wabash Avenue to the center line of Carey Boulevard, at 15 feet distant from and parallel to the north and east property line of said Willamette Boulevard;

The south and west curb line from the center line of Olin Street extended to the southeasterly line of Carey Boulevard extended, at 30 feet distant from and parallel to the south and west property line of said Willamette Boulevard;

The middle of 6-foot wearing surface of sidewalk on the south and west side of Willamette Boulevard from the center line of Olin Street, extended, to the southeasterly line of Carey Boulevard, extended, at 15 feet distant from and parallel to the south and west property line of said Willamette Boulevard.
