Ordinance No. 35749

An ordinance accepting certain property for street purposes, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the following described property be and is hereby accepted by the City of Portland for street purposes:

Commencing at a point in the North line of East Broadway 100 feet west of the west line of Elizabeth Irving's Second addition, and running thence north parallel with and 100 feet distant from the west line of said Elizabeth Irving's Second addition 475.51 feet more or less to the south line of Hancock Street as it now exists, and as shown on the plat of Elizabeth Irving's Second addition, and as shown on the plat of Hancock Street 60 feet; thence south parallel with and 100 feet west of the west line of said Elizabeth Irving's Second addition 475.52 feet more or less to the north line of said East Broadway; thence east along the north line of said East Broadway 60 feet to the place of beginning.

Section 2. That the City Engineer be and is hereby directed to have the deeds to the property described in Section 1 of this ordinance placed on record.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in that it is necessary that the area dedicated to public use as street be accepted at once in order that the proceedings for the improvement of said street may not be delayed; therefore ~~an emergency exists~~ and this ordinance shall be effective from the date its passage by the Council.
