

Ordinance No. 38272

An ordinance naming a certain park and playground of the City of Portland and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, a certain parcel or tract of land, herein below described has been acquired by the City of Portland for park and playground purposes, and

WHEREAS, it is proper and highly desirable that said park and playground be named at this time, therefore

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That certain parcel or tract of land situated in Section 21, township 1 north range 1 east of the Willamette Meridian, within the corporate limits of the City of Portland, Multnomah County, State of Oregon, bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning on Section line between Sections 27 and 28 in Township 1 north, range 1 east, 165.7 feet south of section corner of Sections 21, 22, 27 and 28; thence south 360 feet; thence north 37 degrees 57 minutes West 784.3 feet; thence north 69 degrees 11 minutes East 521.3 feet to section line between Sections 21 and 22; thence north 83 degrees 57 minutes East 308.2 feet to West line of Maryland Avenue; thence south on said west line 481.4 feet; thence south 89 degrees 45 minutes west 306.5 feet to the place of beginning, containing 7.8 acres more or less, heretofore acquired by the City of Portland, State of Oregon for park and playground purposes, be and is hereby named "Overlook Playground."

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: It is necessary that said park and playground be named at this time so that confusion may not exist in the administration of the Bureau of Parks, therefore an emergency is hereby declared and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
