Ordinance No. 38897

An Ordinance amending Section 2 of Ordinance No. 38658, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland Does Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 38658 entitled, "An Ordinance consenting to the laying and maintaining of a water main along a certain right of way of the City of Portland upon certain condition, and declaring an emergency," passed by the Council January 12, 1921, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. The consent hereby expressed is granted upon the express condition that said C. A. Michaelson and Henry M. Meyer file a written unqualified acceptance of all the terms of this ordinance, which written consent shall be filed with the Auditor on or before the 15th day of March, 1921.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: That it is desired that water be supplied to the property of said C. A. Michaelson and Henry M. Meyer without delay, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
