

Ordinance No. 39041

An Ordinance authorizing a warrant to be drawn in payment of the award of the jury in the case of the City of Portland vs. Moy Back Hin, et al. for the condemnation of land for park and playground purposes and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland Does Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and hereby are authorized to draw a warrant in the sum of \$32,000.00 on the fund for parks and playgrounds, payable to Joseph W. Beveridge, County Clerk of Multnomah County, Oregon, in conformity to the verdict of the jury and the judgment of the court in the case of the City of Portland vs. Moy Back Hin, et al. (H 1451), said sum being the amount of the award of the jury at the trial of said cause. The City Attorney is hereby authorized to deposit in the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon, for the County of Multnomah, the warrant hereby authorized and to cause a final judgment to be entered directing the disbursement of said sum by the Clerk of the Court in conformity to the record in said case.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland, in this: That it is for the best interest of the inhabitants of the City of Portland that the park to be acquired in said proceedings be speedily acquired and improved and that the persons whose lands have been condemned should have prompt payment of the jury's award, therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
