

ORDINANCE NO. 43474

An ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to advertise and receive proposals for furnishing lead pipe for the Bureau of Water Works, authorizing a contract therefor, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland Does Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That the Purchasing Agent be and he is hereby authorized and directed to advertise and receive proposals for furnishing-

12,000 lbs., 5/8" AA Pacific Standard Lead Pipe

2,000 lbs., 1/2" AA " " " "

all to be in accordance with the specifications and bidding form therefor, filed in the office of the Purchasing Agent under date of August 20th, 1923, which specifications and bidding form are hereby adopted.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Commissioner of Public Utilities be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for said lead pipe, in accordance with said specifications and bidding form, provided, however, that in case no bids are received which are satisfactory to the Council the Purchasing Agent is hereby authorized to re-advertise therefor until satisfactory bids are received.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland, in this: That said lead pipe is required for immediate use in connection with the installation of water service extensions in the City; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
