Ordinance No. 46674

An ordinance accepting certain property for street purposes in Beech Street, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the following described property be and is hereby accepted by the City of Portland for street purposes:

Beginning at the intersection of the south line of Beech Street and the east line of Hyde Park, an addition to the City of Portland; thence northerly along the east line of Hyde Park, sixty (60) feet to a point in the north line of Beech Street; thence westerly along the north line of Beech Street to a point sixty (60) feet east of the southeast corner of block 23, Hyde Park; thence southerly sixty (60) feet to a point in the south line of Beech Street sixty (60) feet east of the northeast corner of block 32, Hyde Park; thence easterly along the south line of Beech Street to the place of beginning. (Deeded by B.E. Moore and Annie Moore)

Section 2. That the City Engineer be and is hereby directed to have the deeds to the property described in Section 1 of this ordinance placed on record.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: As it is necessary that this property be immediately opened to the public as a city street; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
