Ordinance No. _____

An ordinance authorizing the payment of the claim of Mr. and Mrs. R. V. McDonald in the sum of \$98.50, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Mrs. R. V. McDonald injured her knee by stepping into a hole over one of the City water mains located in Oswego and Olympia Streets, and

WHEREAS, under the circumstances Mrs. McDonald should be reimbursed for her expenses incurred by this accident and Mr. McDonald reimbursed for the time he lost account of having to care for his wife, and

WHEREAS, the City Attorney is of the opinion that said claim should be paid, therefore

THE CITY OF PORTLAND DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized and directed to draw and deliver a warrant in the sum of \$98.50 to Mrs. R. V. McDonald, 117 N. Swenson Street, chargeable to the appropriation for contingencies, provided, however, that the above warrant shall not be delivered by the City Auditor to the said Mrs. R. V. McDonald until the said Mr. and Mrs. R. V. McDonald have filed in the office of said Auditor an agreement, approved by the City Attorney, releasing and relieving the City of Portland from any and all further liability on account of said injury, or future ill effects arising therefrom.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that the faith and credit of the City may be preserved thru prompt payment of its financial obligations, therefore an emergency is hereby declared and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
