Ordinance Noccoops

An Ordinance vacating that portion of Crane Street which lies between the east line of East 21st Street as laid out south of Crane Street, and the west line of East 22nd Street, in the City of Portland, Multnomah County, State of Oregon

whereas, due notice has been given by advertisement thereof for four weeks, to min from August 8, 1930, to September 8, 1930, both dates inclusive, in the Daily Journal of Commerce, the City Official Newspaper, published in the City of Portland, County of Multromah, State of Oregon, that at a regular meeting of the Council to be held September 10, 1930, a petition would be presented to the Council praying for the vacation of that portion of Crane Street lying between the east line of East 21st Street as laid out south of Crane Street, and the west line of East 22nd Street, in the City of Portland, Oregon, which notice, together with due proof of publication thereof, was filed in the office of the Auditor on September 5, 1930, prior to the presentation of said petition to the Council; and

WHEREAS, the petition hereinbefore referred to was duly presented to the Council on said date, namely, Seltember 10, 1930, which said petition set forth a description of said portion of Crane Street sought to be vacated and the reasons for such vacation, the purpose for which the ground is proposed to be used, the circumstances of the case and the names of the persons affected, and said petition was duly signed by arthur Low et al; a n

WHEREAS, there was appended to said patition as a part thereof and as a basis for such vaca ion the consent in writing of the owners in fee simple of all abutting property and of at least two thirds of the real estate fronting upon both sides of the portion of said Crane Street which is proposed to be vacated, estimated upon the frontage of the said portion of said street, such frontage commending at a line drawn equidistant from the termini of said portion of said street proposed to be vacated and extending along such proposed vacation the entire length thereof and two hundred feet in each direction from the termini thereof, except where said street is not continuous, which consent is acknowledged before an officer authorized to take acknowledges.

WHEREAS, the Council upon the presentation of said petition and the filing of proof of publication of the notice

thereof, did fix a meeting of said Council to be held on the 24th day of September, 1930, at 10 o'clock A. M. as the time for hearing said petition and any objections that might be filed thereto; and

WHEREAS, a) said time so fixed by the Council for such hearing said petition was duly presented, heard and considered by the Council, and there were no objections presented thereto and the Council did find, ascertain and determine and does hereby find, ascertain and determine that all of the foregoing recited frets are true, and that all the acts and things above recited have been duly done and performed as required by the charter and ordinances of the city and laws epplicable thereto, and that the public interest vill not be prejudited by the vacation of said portion of said street; and,

WHEREAS, the Council did on said date, to wit, September 24, 1930, grant the grayer of said petition in its entirety; now therefore

The City of Portland Does Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. The findings and action hereinbefore recited are hereby made a matter of record, and the Coancil does hereby find and determine that all of the facts, matters and things hereinbefort recited are true and that all of the acce and things above recived have been done and performed as hereinbefore set forth and as required by law and by the charter and ordinances of the cityo

Section 2. That all of that portion of Crane Street which lies between the east line of Bast Elst Street as laid out south of Crane Street, and the west line of East 22nd Street, in the City of Portland, Multnomah County, State of Oregon, be and the same is hereby vacated, and said vacation is hereby me a ratter of record, and it is hereby provided that the Auditor sh ll file with the County Clerk of Multnomah County, Oregen, a certified copy of this crainance, and shall obtain from the County Surveyor of Multnomar County, Oregon, a proper entry on the plat records as provided by lawo

Nothing contained herein shall sause or require the removal or abandonment of any sewer, water main, conduit of any kind, wires, poles or any other thing used or intended to be used for any public service and the right is hereby reserved to maintain, continue, repair, reconstruct, renew, replace, rebuild and/or enlarge any and all such things, if any there be, on said portion of said street hereby vacatedo
