ORDINANCE NO.

An Ordinance transferring from the jurisdiction of the Delinquent Tax Committee Lots 1 and 2, Block 21, Kings Heights Addition to the City of Portland, to the jurisdiction and use of the Bureau of Water Works, appropriating \$900.00 out of the Water Construction Fund, payable to the Assessment Collection Fund, authorizing the Mayor and Auditor to draw a warrant, repealing Ordinance No. 62427, entitled, "An Ordinance authorizing the Commissioner of Public Affairs to purchase certain real property for the use of the Bureau of Water Works, appropriating \$900.00 out of the Water Construction Fund for such purpose, authorizing the Mayor and Auditor to draw a warrant in payment therefor, and declaring an emergency", passed by the Council April 20, 1932, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Lots 1 and 2, Block 21, Kings Heights Addition to the City of Portland, Oregon, be and is hereby transferred from the jurisdiction of the Delinquent Tax Committee to the jurisdiction and use of the Bureau of Water Works. To reimburse the Delinquent Tax Committee for the said real property the sum of \$900.00 is hereby appropriated out of the Water Construction Fund and the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant on said fund for said amount, payable to the Assessment Collection Fund.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 62427, entitled, "An Ordinance authorizing the Commissioner of Public Affairs to purchase certain real property for the use of the Bureau of Water Works, appropriating \$900.00 out of the Water Construction Fund for such purpose, authorizing the Mayor and Auditor to draw a warrant in payment therefor, and declaring an emergency", passed by the Council April 20, 1932, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, and safety of the City of Portland in this: That said property is now being used by

the Bureau of Water Works and transfer of same should be immediately made, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.

An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Auditor to draw warrants on the General Fund to provide for the expense of checking recall petitions, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Auditor was, under the provisions of Ordinance No. 62400, authorized to incur the necessary expense in checking recall petitions presented for the recall of the Mayor and two Commissioners; therefore

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized to draw warrants on the General Fund, chargeable to the appropriation for Expense of Elections, in favor of the following named persons for the amounts set apposite their names respectively, to provide for payment of services rendered in checking recall petitions:
