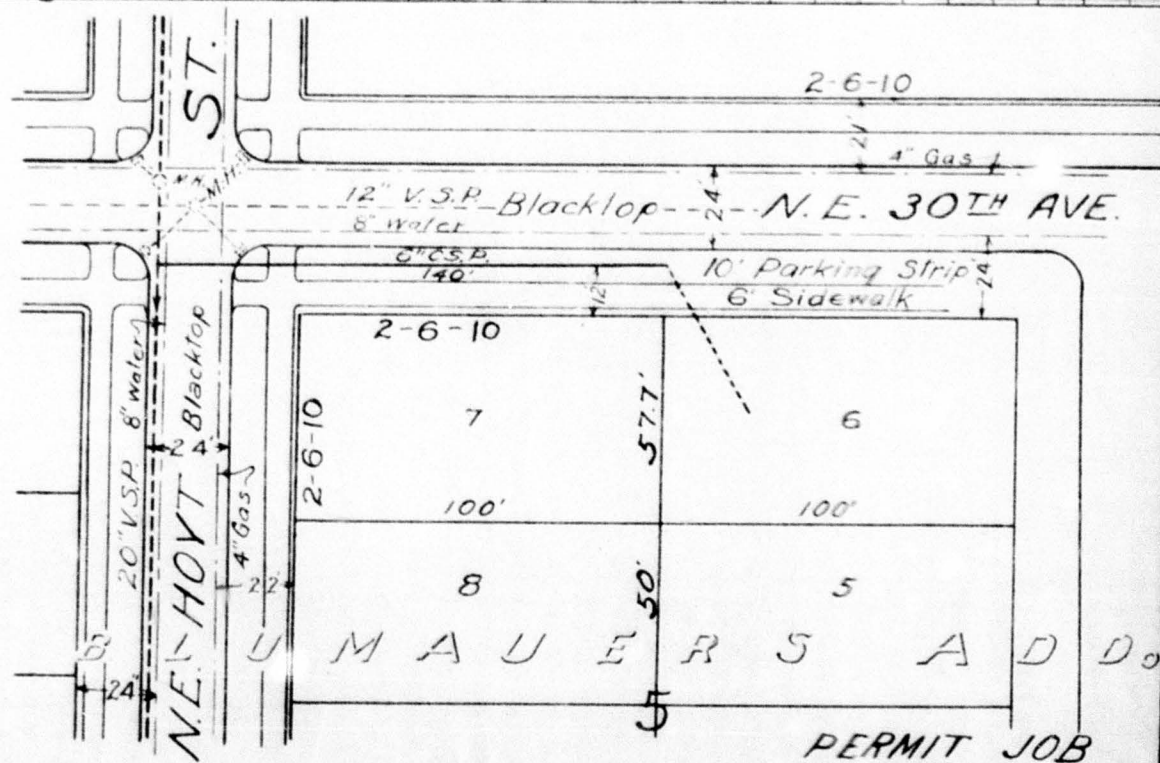
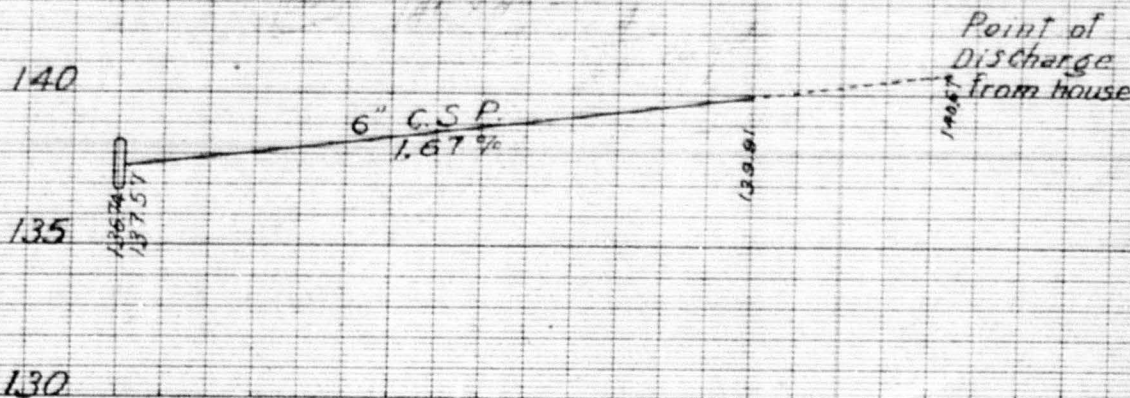

## Ordinance No. 77429

An Ordinance granting a permit to Morlan Plumbing Company, 4829 N.E. Union Ave., to construct a sewer in the parking strip on the east side of N.E. 30th Ave. from 100 feet north of the north line of N.E. Hoyt St. to the sewer in N.E. Hoyt St., and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. A permit is hereby granted to Morlan Plumbing Company (hereinafter referred to as the grantee) to construct a sewer in the parking strip on the east side of N.E. 30th Ave. from 100 feet north of the north line of N.E. Hoyt St. to the sewer in N.E. Hoyt St., the work to be done under the supervision of the City Engineer and in accordance with standard specifications of the City of Portland and the attached plan marked Exhibit "A" and made a part of this ordinance. The grantee shall preserve and replace the grass sod over the trench in the parking strips adjacent to Lot 7, Block 5, Blumauer's Addition, and shall maintain the surface of the said parking strip against settlement for a period of two years after the completion of the sewer.

The grantee shall assume full responsibility for any accidents or damage which may occur during the construction of the said sewer, and shall hold the City of Portland, the City Engineer, and each and all of the officers and employees of said City free and harmless from any claims for damages to persons or property which may be occasioned by any construction and/or maintenance of said sewer until the same is accepted by the City Engineer.

Within ten (10) days from the date hereof, the grantee shall pay to the City Treasurer for the credit of the Engineering Rotary Account a fee of \$9.06 to cover the cost of engineering and inspection, said amount being 6% of the Engineer's estimate of the cost of the work.

Within ten (10) days from the date hereof, the grantee shall file with the City Auditor a document satisfactory to the City Attorney accepting the terms and conditions hereof.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that the said sewer may be constructed without undue delay; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
