## Ordinance No. 80625

An Ordinance granting a permit to G. G. Swanson, 8402 N. Kellogg St., to construct a sewer in N. John Ave. from approximately 120 feet north of the north line of N. Jersey St. to the existing sewer in N. Jersey St., and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. A permit is hereby granted to G. G. Swanson (hereinafter referred to as the grantee) to construct a 6-inch sanitary sewer in N. John Ave. from approximately 120 feet north of the north line of N. Jersey St. to the existing sewer in N. Jersey St., the said sewer to be located 14 feet east of the west line of N. John Ave. and to be constructed in accordance with the standard plans and specifications of the City of Portland, and under the supervision of the City Engineer as shown on the attached sketch marked Exhibit "A" and made a part of this ordinance, this permit being granted under the following conditions:

(a) Within ten (10) days from the date hereof, the grantee shall pay to the City Treasurer for the credit of the Engineering Rotary Account a fee of \$13.64 to cover the cost of engineering and inspection, said amount being 6% of the City Engineer's estimate of the cost of the work.

(b) The grantee shall hold the City of Portland, the City Engineer, and each and all of the officers and employes of said City free and harmless from any claims for damages to persons or property which may be occasioned by any construction and/or maintenance carried on under the permit hereby granted until the said sewer has been accepted by the City Engineer.

(c) Within ten (10) days from the date hereof, the grantee shall file with the City Auditor a document satisfactory to the City Attorney accepting the terms and conditions hereof.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in

this: In order that sewer facilities may be provided for the property to be served by the said sewer without undue delay; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
