WHEREAS at the Municipal Non-partisan Primary Election held on May 19, 2020, a measure proposed to voters by City Council referral with the ballot title caption "Renew Motor Vehicle Fuel Tax for Street Repair, Maintenance, Safety" and such measure was designated on the ballot as Measure 26-209, and according to the official canvas 179,286 votes were cast in favor of said measure, and 53,032 were cast against said measure, now, therefore, it is hereby
