

ORDINANCE No. 94572

An Ordinance to re-establish the curb lines of S.E. 91st Avenue between S.E. Foster Road and S.E. Reedway and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Council finds it advisable, prior to further improvement of S.E. 91st Avenue from the northerly line of S.E. Foster Road to the south line of S.E. Reedway, to establish the curb lines of said street at a distance of 14.5 feet from and parallel to the center line of the street.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that said curb may be constructed without unnecessary delay; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
