

An Ordinance declaring the proportionate share of the cost of constructing the sewer in Crosby

Street, from

the south line of Cherry street to a connection with the sewer in Crosby street 50 feet south of the south line of Halsbury Street, to be assessed to the property benefited by the construction thereof and directing an entry of such assessment in the docket of City liens.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. The Common Council of the City of Portland having ascertained the probable cost of the construction of the sewer in Crosby

Street, from

the south line of Cherry street to a connection with the sewer in Crosby street 50 feet south of the south line of Halsbury Street, as provided by Ordinance No 10490, to be the sum of \$ 1481⁶⁰

Now, therefore, said sum is hereby assessed to the several lots and parts of lots and tracts of land in the respective amounts set opposite the number and description thereof, in section (3) of this Ordinance, as being benefited by the construction thereof in said amounts, due notice of the assessment hereby made having been given by publication of the same in the *The Evening Telegram* for five consecutive days.

Sec. 2. The Auditor is hereby directed to enter a statement of the assessment hereby made in the docket of City liens, and cause notice thereof to be published as provided by the City Charter.
