

Ordinance No. 13854

An Ordinance prohibiting the conducting of pool rooms or the sale of pools or gambling upon the result of horse races.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1: It is hereby declared to be unlawful for any person either as owner, proprietor, manager, employee, or lessee or otherwise, within the Corporate Limits of the City of Portland, to conduct any book-making establishment, or to sell pools or tickets or to gamble in any manner whatsoever upon horse races either within or without the corporate limits of the City of Portland, and any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof before the Municipal Court be fined by a fine not to exceed \$500.00 or by imprisonment in the City Jail for a period not to exceed ninety days.
