

Homeownership new construction completion timeline



Summary

- 10 (CET) Citywide DPAL's were utilized within 1 year
- Average purchase price of the 51 households = \$346,918
- New development units are necessary for existing goals and timelines with limited DPAL's available
- Leveraged resources: Wells Fargo Lift, Home Start funds, Individual Development Account (IDA) & OHCS funds
