I am recommending reappointing Whit Middlecoff to a second four-year term on the Adjustment Committee.

- Whit has served on the Committee since July of 2016. He has been practicing as an architect with GBD for nearly 25 years where he has worked on a variety of residential, mixed-use, commercial and institutional development in the metro area.
