He said I could and he would be home. I arrived at about 0230 hours and he invited me in. In KN-Moss was present. I asked if VI-Jenks had been there the other night and he said she had. I asked him to tell me what happened. I showed him a photo I had taken of the security footage and he said it looked like her, but she had a long green coat on.</p> <p>KN-Captain said that VI-Jenks showed with suitcases and said she had just gotten back from a small town that started with a P. I asked if it was Pendleton and he said that was the name. He said it was about 2030 hours. He said he had not seen her in about four (4) months. She said she was very intoxicated and that they talked and made out. He said that they talked about working things out and that he loved her. He said that as they were back in the living room area that he saw she had two-beers in her purse. He said that when she drank she became mean and verbally abusive. He said that he dumped them out and she grabbed a bottle of Vodka he had on the counter and he took that away as well.</p> <p>At this point KN-Captain said he wondered if he was going to need representation later. I told him I did not know, but that I was just there to find out what was going on and where VI-Jenks had been. I asked if he would need one and he said no, not at this time.</p> <p>He then continued that she came upset and said she wanted a cab. KN-Captain said he called one for her and I asked at what time. He looked at his phone and he said he made the call at 2250 hours and called 503-227-1212 (Radio cab) and thought it was a Broadway cab. He said the cab called him at 2302 hours and said he was outside. (503-998-5278) (I later called the cab company and they said a Jay Borich drove cab #91 and had picked her up at 2206 hours and the meter went off at 2331, not sure where. I tried calling the driver and left a message) he said he loaded several bags for her and that she even left a couple of bags behind. He said that was the last he saw of her. I asked him if she would have gone to a motel near SE 99th and Stark. I asked if he would stay at the Montavilla and he said no, that she thought of herself as more upscale. He said she would be at the Chestnut or better the Ramada.</p> <p>I asked him VI-Jenks may have been sexually interested in multiple partners and he said that she had in the past and even had sex with a cab driver when she was drunk in his house.</p> <p>KN-Moss said he had met VI-Jenks at AA meetings sometime ago, but had gone to a movie with her last week on the on 09/28/13 and had a text from her on 10/5/13. He said he had not seen her since.</p>			
	<p>8) FOLLOW-UP: I left there and went to area motel as it appeared that VI-Jenks had walked to the club from the northwest. I checked the Chestnut and she was not registered. I then went over to the Ramada and asked if VI-Jenks was registered there. They said no. I called KN-Captain and asked if VI-Jenks would use an AKA in a motel. He said that she might, but that she had used a "government" discount at motels. I asked the clerk (Shelly Francisco DOB: 01/20/71, 503-252-7400) if a Tiffany using a government discount was there. She said Jenks, Tiffany was in room #117.</p> <p>I this time I told her not to let anyone in that room and I placed a call to the MCT. I later briefed the MCT at Gresham PD at 0730 hours. I left a copy of my report.</p> <p>Nothing further.</p>
