ORDINANCE NO. 176247

*Authorize an Agreement between Metropolitan Human Rights Center and the Immigrant and Refugee Community Organization for Project Interwoven Tapestry.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City of Portland, Metropolitan Human Rights Center (MHRC), in partnership with the International Refugee Center of Oregon (IRCO), jointly applied for a grant from the National Conference of State Legislatures (NCSL) for a public-private collaboration on a 2 1/2 year research and demonstration project called Project Interwoven Tapestry, designed to expand opportunities and better integrate Portland's refugees and immigrants.
- 2. The NCSL has awarded IRCO a grant to implement the project over the next two and a half years.
- 3. \$35,500 of the grant funding has been set aside by IRCO for MHRC, for FY 01-02, to increase linkages between the existing neighborhood structure and refugee and immigrant communities in order to improve new neighbor integration. Additional funding may be available for FY 02/03.
- 4. The project will aid in the integration of refugee and immigrant neighbors into the existing neighborhood structure, and will provide increased opportunities for civic involvement among new Americans.
- 5. No match is required but the MHRC will be providing a local contribution to this project through the provision of staff time already appropriated in ONI's FY 01-02 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs and the City Auditor are hereby authorized to sign an agreement with IRCO for Project Interwoven Tapestry.
 - b. The Mayor and the City Auditor are hearby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland grant money from IRCO in the amount of \$35,500:
