PURPOSE
The purpose of this agreement is to define the responsibilities of the Bureau of Environmental Services (BES and the property owner implementing the pilot project. The goal of the Willamette Stormwater Control Program is to promote stormwater controls that reduce combined sewer overflows and increase sewer system capacity. The Program is partnering with a limited number of property owners to implement demonstration projects.

RESPONSIBILITIES
The Willamette Stormwater Control Program shall:
Fund the agreed upon project for a total of \$ Twenty five percent (25%) of this amount will be paid when the approved project has received all necessary development and building permits. The remaining amount will be paid after the project is complete and has passed final inspections.
The Property Owner(s) shall:
Design, obtain permits for, and construct the project as described in the proposal and agreed upon by BES. The owner's representative will immediately inform BES in writing of any changes to the design or function

Develop and implement an Operations and Maintenance (O & M) Plan for the facility. The O & M Plan must meet the requirements of the BES Stormwater Management Manual.

of the facility that results from circumstances that arise during construction, and will not implement any

City's written agreement.

Allow BES workers, or their representatives, scheduled access to the site to observe the facility and conduct monitoring of the performance of the facility. This right of access will continue for a period of 5 years.

Allow BES employees to publicize the nature and location of the facility. Allow BES to post a sign at the facility describing the benefits associated with the project.

By request, allow scheduled visits by interested citizens to provide educational opportunities. This opportunity will be offered for a period of 5 years.

Submit a revised final budget for the project upon its completion, documenting costs for design, materials, and labor.

OTHER ISSUES

The City is not liable or responsible for any injury or harm resulting from the construction, maintenance, or existence of the facility.

If any future alterations of the site come under the authority of the BES Stormwater Management Manual, applicable requirements in the Manual will apply to the site. The Manual requires stormwater management measures at new and redeveloping properties.
