

ORDINANCE NO. 176276

* Agreement with Southeast Uplift, Inc. for \$66,219 for the Kerns Target Area and provide for payment.
(Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

SECTION 1. The Council finds that:

1. The City has created a Community and Targeted Initiatives Program Area, within the Bureau of Housing and Community Development, to identify and designate small geographic areas located within low/moderate income neighborhoods for multi-year assistance to carry out community directed revitalization activities.
2. The Bureau conducted a competitive process for selection of designated target areas and Southeast Uplift applied for the Kerns Neighborhood.
3. The Kerns neighborhood was selected by a citizen committee. Kerns has completed its organizing and outreach, has identified its target area, has developed its action plan and is continuing in the process of implementing its plan.
4. The implementation grant will provide Southeast Uplift and Kerns neighborhood with assistance to continue their outreach to Kerns residents, businesses and other partners, to implement the action plan and to carry out projects within the target area and neighborhood.
5. Funding for this project in the amount of \$66,219 is available in the Bureau of Housing and Community Development FY 01/02 approved budget.
6. The City now desires to enter into a formal agreement with the Subrecipient in the amount of \$66,219 for outreach activities, implementation of the action plan and specific projects under the Target Area Designation Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Works is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Southeast Uplift for the Kerns TAD 01/02 in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A (attached to the original ordinance only).
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for said contract from the Community Development Block Grant Fund.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in funding would interrupt Southeast Uplift's ability to provide the Kerns TAD 01/02; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
