
What is PCEF?

- Invests in climate action that advances racial and social justice
- Ballot measure passed by more than 65% of Portland
- Oregon's first environmental measure created and led by communities of color
- Generates \$40-60M annually for clean energy investments in Portland
- 1% gross receipts tax on sales in Portland by corporations with \$1B+ sales nationally and \$500M+ in Portland. Exemptions for things like groceries, utilities.

- To make final funding recommendations to the City Council;
 - To make recommendations on changes to the PCEF code
 - To evaluate applications; and
 - To review our performance and report that performance to the public and City Council

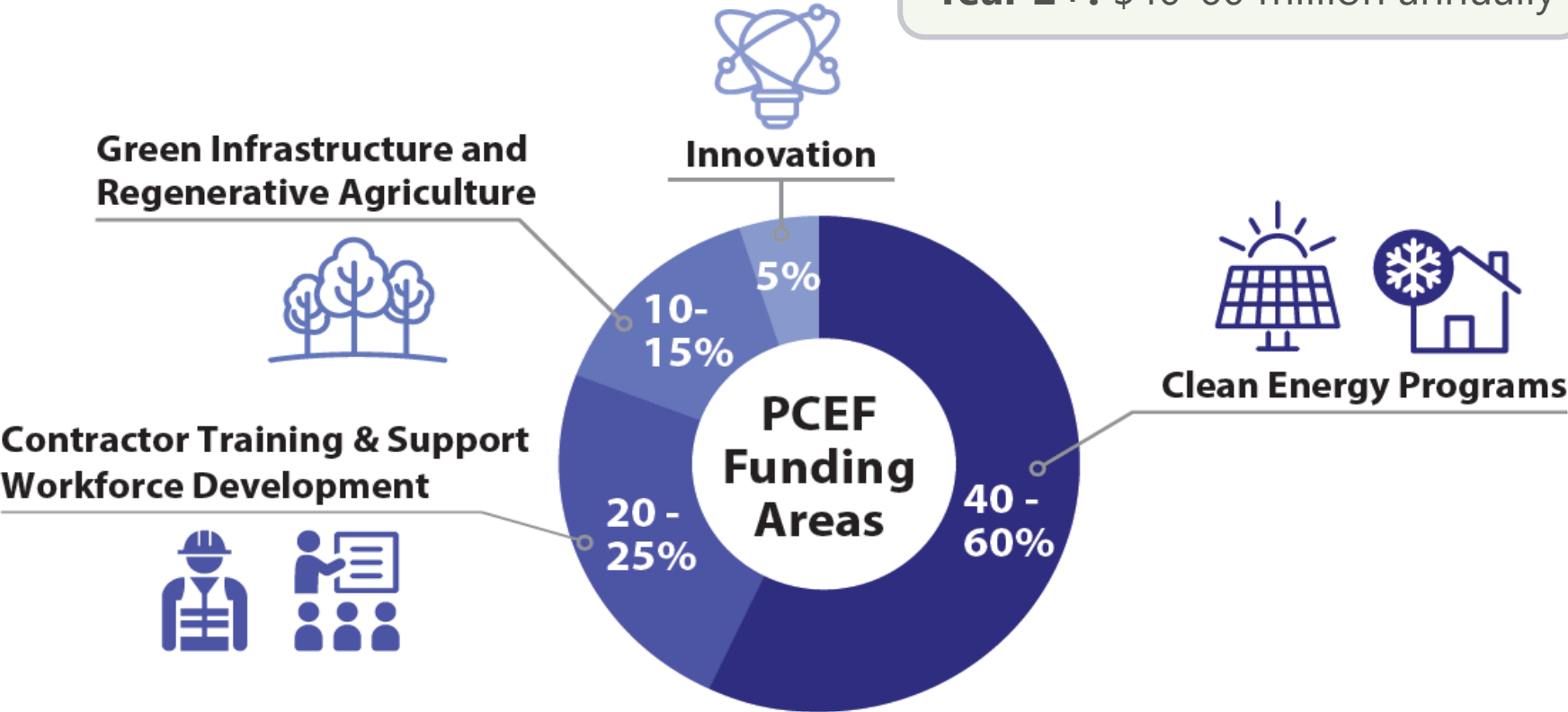

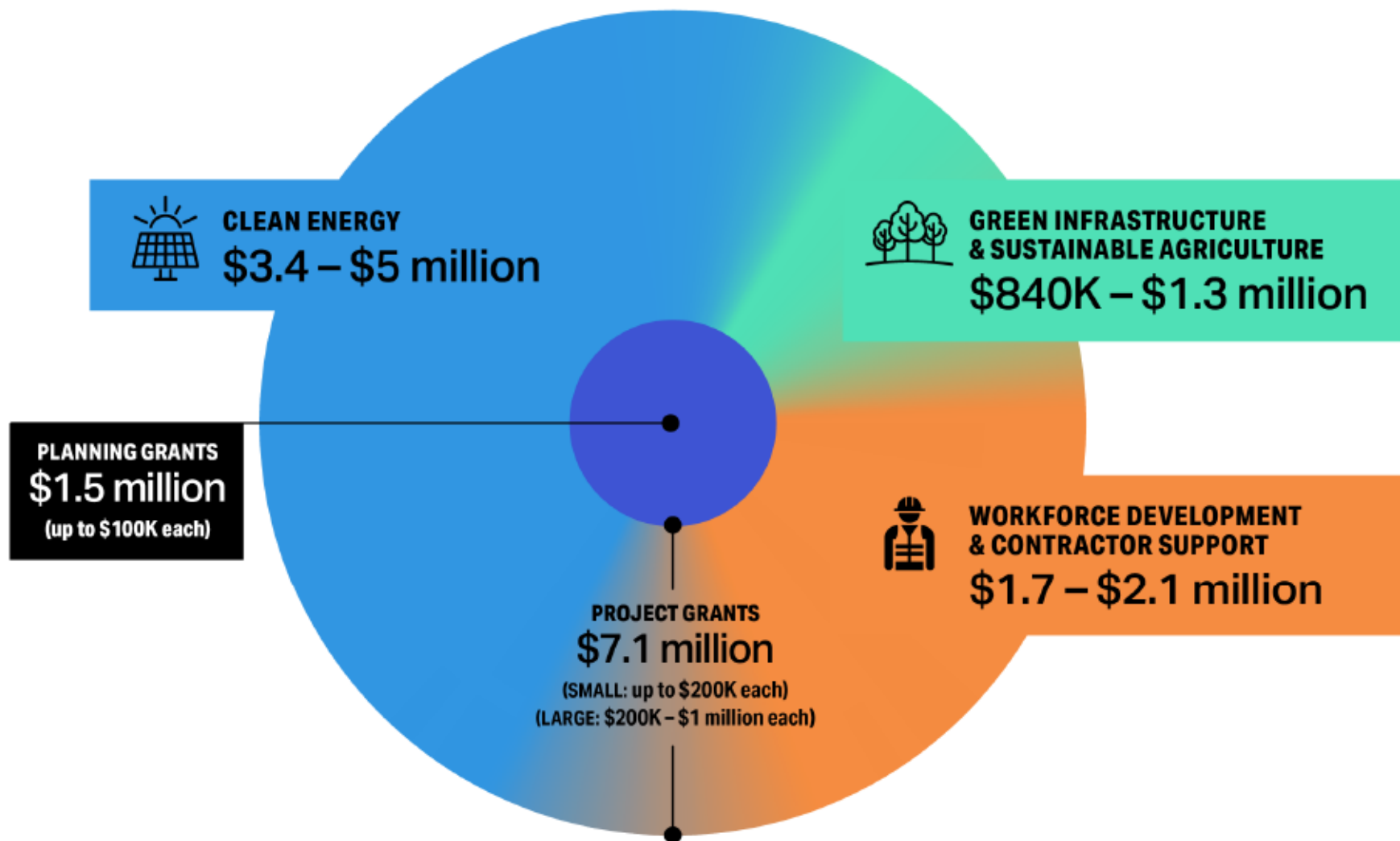
What projects can be funded?

Year 1: \$8.6 million
Year 2+: \$40-60 million annually

Other grant types:

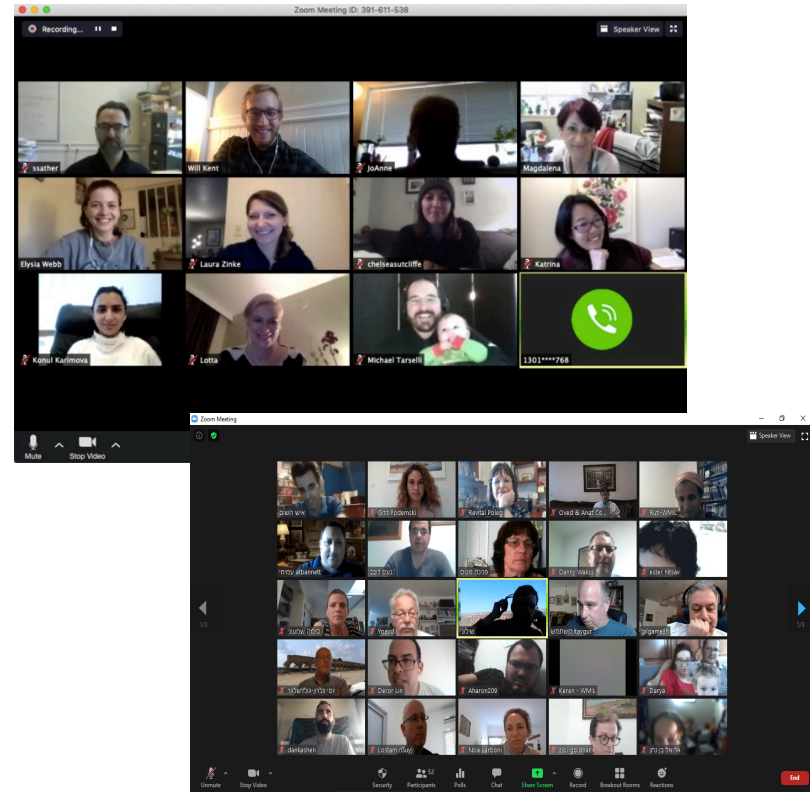
- Application support grants – up to \$5,000

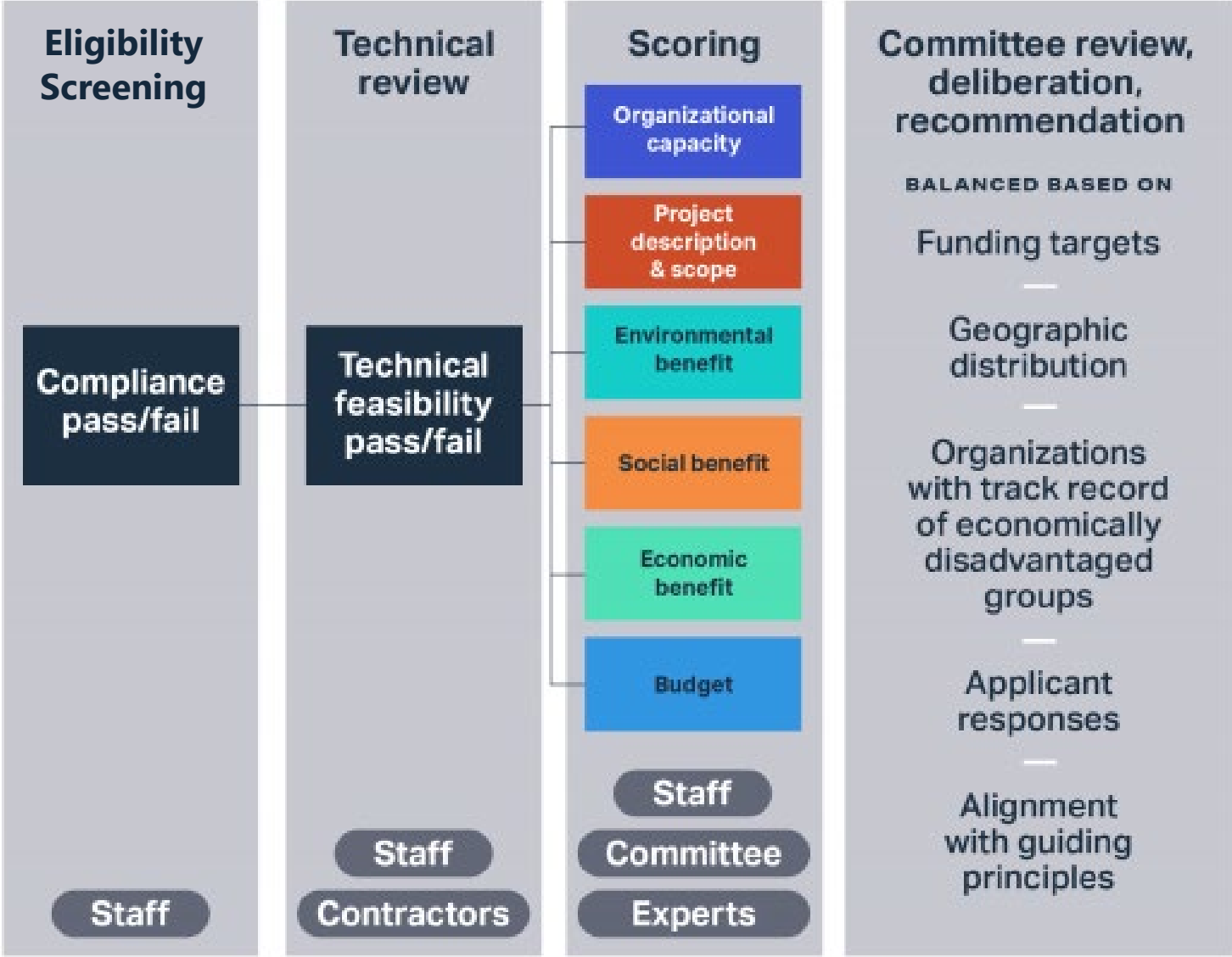
