RESOLUTION No. 37507

Dissolve the Unreinforced Masonry Building Workgroup (Resolution)

WHEREAS, the City of Portland faces a significant risk from a catastrophic earthquake from the Cascadia Subduction Zone and smaller faults beneath the City; and

WHEREAS, URM buildings pose a grave risk in an earthquake, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 37455 and 37364, the City appointed two URM Work Groups in October 2019 and directed the groups to evaluate reasonable seismic retrofit support, incentives, and voluntary program standards and present their findings, including both majority and minority reports as appropriate, at a City Council work session within one year of the first URM building workgroup meeting; and

WHEREAS, URM Work Groups convened twice before the Governor issued a pandemic stay-at-home order; and

WHEREAS, the City is continuing to experience the effects of a worldwide pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the City is also currently experiencing widespread demonstrations and protests related to Police violence and other forms of racist oppression; and

WHEREAS, the City's Emergency Management resources are now focused on response to the current emergencies; and

WHEREAS, disasters disproportionately harm historically underserved communities, including Black, Indigenous, and other communities of color, immigrants and refugees, and people with disabilities; and

WHEREAS, many community members are currently also focused on response to the current emergencies; and

WHEREAS, it is not possible to assure adequate resources and participation in a work groups to address the risks from URM buildings in an earthquake within the timeframe set out by Council; and

WHEREAS, it is not known when the URM Work Group could reasonably be reconvened;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council hereby dissolves the URM Work Group created in 2019 pursuant to Resolution No. 37455;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution supersedes the provisions of Resolution No. 37364 and 37455 concerning the creation and duties of the URM Work Group.
