Accept bid of Kodiak Pacific Construction Co. for the East Portland Access to Employment and Education Project for \$5,628,899 (Procurement Report - Bid No. 00001482)

TO THE COUNCIL:

On September 25, 2019, Council approved Ordinance Number 189707 for Procurement Services to competitively solicit the East Portland Access to Employment and Education Project in accordance with PCC 5.34. The Chief Procurement Officer has advertised and received bids for Bid Number 00001482 on behalf of the Portland Bureau of Transportation, with a project construction estimate of \$6,252,907.11. PBOT rated the project estimate confidence level as High.

Bids were opened on August 11, 2020, and Five (5) bids were received. The low bid from Kodiak Pacific Construction Co., was responsive to the solicitation requirements, thus it is recommended that their bid be accepted at the estimated quoted for a total bid amount of \$5,628,898.98.

Ordinance No. 179568 authorized the Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) to participate in ODOT's Local Public Agency Certification Program for the delivery of federal-aid projects. On June 29, 2011, ODOT's Director informed the Mayor that PBOT had successfully completed the requirements to become fully certified, and City Council accepted ODOT's certification acknowledgement by Ordinance No. 184710. This is a federal-aid transportation project under the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) Federal-Aid Highway Program. Under ODOT's certification, this project will be reviewed and audited by ODOT for federal-aid project compliance. **Introduced by** Mayor Ted Wheeler

Part of the certification is that ODOT shall administer on behalf of the City, ODOT's Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE), Equal Employment Opportunity, and On-The-Job Training (OJT) programs. As such, ODOT establishes the minimum DBE goals for each federal-aid project in compliance with 49 CFR 26. The criteria used in assigning project goals includes: project location, size, duration, dollar value and the availability of DBE firms that can perform identified subcontracting opportunities. This project has a 12% DBE goal. ODOT deemed Kodiak Pacific Construction Co. to be responsive to the DBE requirement. Kodiak Pacific Construction Co. has a committed DBE participation goal of 12.17%. State based certifications other than DBE are not reported in Federal Aid projects.
