Whereas, “Shrill” is beginning its third season of production in Portland; and

Whereas, “Shrill” has been an innovator in storytelling, both on screen as well as behind the camera; and

Whereas, the film website Rotten Tomatoes estimates that “sharp social commentary and a star-making performance from Aidy Bryant . . . create a show that proves self-acceptance isn't one size fits all” ; and

Whereas, “Shrill” joins an array of television shows that have filmed in Portland across several seasons including “The Librarians,” “Portlandia,” “Grimm,” “Trinkets,” and “The Birch”; and

Whereas, “Shrill” marks the continued collaboration between the City of Portland and a production team led by Aidy Bryant, Alexandra Rushfield, Lindy West, Brownstone Productions, Warner Bros. Television, Hulu, and Broadway Video; and

Whereas, it has hired over 750 crew members over its three years and has had an economic impact of over \$50 million as part of the nearly half a billion dollars of direct in-state spending by the film and media industry; and

Whereas, “Shrill” is as culturally significant as it is economically significant to Portland, contributing to our renown as a deeply creative culture; and

Whereas, “Shrill” has had as significant an impact behind the camera as it does in front of the camera promoting the work of a diverse local cast and crew as well as the uniqueness of the City of Portland to an international audience; and

Whereas, Portland City Council has previously acknowledged and affirmed support for the TV and film industry and the important role it plays in helping to make Portland a vibrant, prosperous, and livable community within City Council Resolution 37391;
