

ORDINANCE No. 176308

* Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation to provide funding for engineering and construction of transportation improvements on SE Hawthorne Boulevard between SE 20th and SE 55th Avenue. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City Council adopted the Hawthorne Boulevard Transportation Plan on July 30, 1997 (Resolution No. 35632).
2. Between October 2000 and June 2001, staff from the Portland Office of Transportation worked with a Citizens Advisory Committee, neighborhood residents and business owners to refine the plan and identify priorities for construction. Proposed improvements include curb extensions, pedestrian crossing improvements, traffic signal improvements, transit enhancements, and bike boulevard and bike parking improvements.
3. The total project cost is estimated at \$2,108,000.
4. The Metro Council and the Oregon Transportation Commission approved \$1,500,000 of Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) funds for preliminary engineering and construction of improvements identified in the Hawthorne Boulevard Transportation Plan as a part of the 2000 - 2005 Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program.
5. Transportation System Development Charge funds are budgeted for the project to provide the matching funds and the remaining balance of the project costs. Funds for the match requirement are budgeted in FY 01/02 – FY 04/05 for the Bureau of Transportation Engineering & Development.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement similar in form to the agreement attached to the original of this ordinance, and by this reference made a part hereof.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in executing this agreement will delay design and construction of these improvements; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
