

ORDINANCE No. 149025

An Ordinance adjusting the rate of pay for certain classifications, amending the Compensation Plan, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. That some classifications have entry rates below the new federal minimum wage and should be adjusted accordingly.
2. That new rates should be established effective January 1, 1980 and the Compensation Plan amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The salary rates for the following classifications are fixed effective January 1, 1980, and the Compensation Plan amended accordingly:


