

ORDINANCE No. 149033

An Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to call for bids beginning January 16, 1980 to construct a pressure reducing station at Dam #2 for the Bureau of Water Works, authorizing a contract, authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. That it will be necessary to build a pressure reducing station at Dam #2 in the Bull Run Watershed.
2. That delay in bidding on the construction of the pressure reducing station will impact the construction schedule of other critical projects including the hydroelectric powerplant.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Purchasing Agent shall advertise for bids beginning January 16, 1980 using specifications filed in his office and in the event that no satisfactory bid is received, shall readvertise on the same basic specifications until a satisfactory bid is received.
- b. A contract is authorized with the most favorable bidder as designated by the Council.
- c. The Mayor and the Auditor hereby are authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the 1979-80 Budget, Bureau of Water Works, BUC 18600374, Project Code 1153, Object Code 630, when demand is presented, approved by the proper authorities.


Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with the construction may result in additional expense, and will unnecessarily deprive the City of the benefits of completion of the contract at an early date; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
