ordinance no. 149043

An Ordinance authorizing a temporary loan up to \$1,500,000 from the Sewage Disposal Fund to the Improvement Warrant Sinking Fund for a period of 90 days beginning February 1, 1980, providing for repayment with interest May 1, 1980, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. That a contract for the construction of the Arnold Creek
 Sanitary Sewer System, a Local Improvement District, has been
 entered into, which contract provides for payment in cash
 from the Improvement Warrant Sinking Fund.
- 2. That the sale of General Obligation Improvement Warrants is anticipated to occur within 90 days, but payment of sums pursuant to the above contract will be due prior to the sale.
- 3. That there is a need for \$1,500,000 to provide for these payments until the General Obligation Improvement Warrant sale occurs.
- 4. That there is \$1,500,000 available through this period in the Sewage Disposal Fund and that a loan of \$1,500,000 should be made from the Sewage Disposal Fund No. 3 (BUC 14300228) to the Improvement Warrant Sinking Fund No. 38 (BUC 48975011) pursuant to the authority granted in ORS 294.460 for a period of 90 days with interest at the rate of nine and one-half (9.5) percent per annum.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. A temporary loan from the Sewage Disposal Fund No. 3 (BUC 14300228) to the Improvement Warrant Sinking Fund No. 38 (BUC 48975011) up to the amount of \$1,500,000 for the period beginning February 1, 1980, until May 1, 1980, is hereby authorized; such funds to be returned along with interest without further Council action.

ORDINANCE No.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the loan is needed immediately in order that payments for said contract may proceed in an orderly manner; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
