## ORDINANCE NO 149045

(SEWER-TIME AND MANNER)

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An ordinance providing for the time and manner of constructing the N. Hamlin Avenue between N. Willis Boulevard and N. Hunt Street Sanitary Sewer.

## THE CITY OF PORTLAND ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the N. Hamlin Avenue between N. Willis Boulevard and N. Hunt Street Sanitary Sewer, shall be constructed as follows:

that the cost of said snitary sewer shall be assessed as provided by the Chartor and Ordinances of said City upon the property specially and peculiarly benefited thereby, which property is hereby determined and declared to be all the lots, parts theref, and parcels of land within the district of said City described as follows: Beginning at a point on the east line of N. Hamlin Avenue at the northwest. corner of Lot 18, Block 4, Peninsular Addition No. 2; thence east 100 feet, more or less, to the northeast corner of said Lot 15; thence south a distance of 350 feet, more or less, to the southeast corner of Lot 5 of said Block 4: thence west along the south line of said Lot 5 to Its south west corner; thence southwesterrly to the southeast corner of Lot 37, Block 3, Peninsular Addition No. 2: thence west along the south line of said Lot 37 to its southwest corner; thence north along the west lines of Lots 37-and 36 of said Block 3 to the northwest corner of said Lot 36; thence east along the north line of said Lot 36 to the west line of N. Hamlin Avenue; thence north along said west line a distance of 325 feet; thence easterly to the point of beginning; that the cost of said sanitary sewer construction in accordance with saidplans, specifications and estimates is

\$17,460.00; that advertising costs, and a foo for engineering and superintendence will be added to the final cost in accordance with the provisions of the Code of the City of Provision Section 2. That portion of the street necessary to be used for digging the trench shall be cleared of all obstacles (except gas and water mains) at the expense of the contractor, who shall, after the pipe is laid and the trench filled, replace the pavement and all portions of the street improvements disturbed, leaving the street is as good order as the same was when the work was begun, except such portions as the Council may direct to be omitted for the purpose of making other improvements.

Section 3. The contractor shall take and have entire charge of the work during its progress, and shall be responsible for any loss or accident resulting from carelessness or neglect, and the said sewer improvement shall be completed to the satisfaction of the Council of the City of Portland.

Section 4. The sewer improvement provided for in this Ordinance shall be completed within the time fixed by the Council, and the contract shall contain a provision that for each day required to complete said contract, after the expiration of the time fixed for its completion, the contractor or contractors shall forfeit to the City of Portland the sum prescribed in the General Specifications adopted pursuant to Section 17.16.010 of the Code of the City of Portland, Oregon.

Section 5. The contract shall contain a stipulation to the effect that the person, firm or corporation to whom the contract shall be let shall look for payment only to the fund to be assessed upon the property liable to pay for such sewer improvement, and collected and paid into the City Treasury for that purpose, and that they will not require the City of Portland by any legal process or otherwise to pay the same out of any other fund, except as provided by the Charter.

Section 6. The contract shall be subject to the provisions of the Code of the City of Portland, Oregon, and of all other Ordinances of the City of Portland applicable thereto.

Section 7. The time for completing the laying and construction of the sewer provided for by this Ordinance 90 days from the date of the awarding of the contract for the aforesaid sewer.

Section 8. The Auditor is hereby directed to advertise for proposals for the construction of the aforesaid sewer.
