### ORDINANCE NO. 149048

An Ordinance granting to Northwest Natural Gas Company an additional extension of time to January 6, 1981 to comply with Section 1, Condition (h) of Ordinance No. 138348, which vacated portions of NW 2nd Avenue and NW Flanders Street, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

#### Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. At the request of Northwest Natural Gas Company, the City by Ordinance No. 138348 passed by the Council June 6, 1974, vacated, subject to certain conditions, portions of NW 2nd Avenue and NW Flanders Street to provide a suitable site for a four block development of office and retail space.
- 2. Section 1, Condition (h), of said ordinance required that in the event construction of a four block development of offices and retail space is not commenced within two years from the effective date of the vacating ordinance, Northwest Natural Gas Company, its successors or assigns, shall dedicate for street purposes, in an improved condition acceptable to the City Engineer, all of the street areas received by it resulting from the passage of the vacating ordinance.
- 3. That due to a general economic slowdown and other complications following passage of the vacating ordinance, the petitioner requested and was granted by Ordinances No. 141708, 142954, 143202, 145010, and 147166, extensions of time to January 6, 1980 to comply with said Condition (h).
- 4. That by letter dated December 19, 1979, Northwest Natural Gas Company advised that a letter of agreement with Daon Corporation had been signed and it appeared development of the four block parcel would likely be undertaken in 1980, and so requested the date for compliance with Section 1, Condition (h) of Ordinance No. 138348 be extended to January 6, 1981.

## ORDINANCE No.

- 5. That the Council by Ordinance No. 1490U2 allowed a two week extension of time to January 17, 1980 to comply with said Condition (h).
- 6. That in order to allow Daon Corporation and Northwest Natural Gas Company an opportunity to seek approval of the proposed development, the Council now finds that the requested extension to January 6, 1981 should be allowed.

#### NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The time allowed to Northwest Natural Gas Company to comply with Section 1, Condition (h) of Ordinance No. 138348 is hereby extended to January 6, 1981.
- 6. All other conditions of said Ordinance No. 138348 shall remain in force and effect.
- Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists, because delay in the enactment of this ordinance could cause abandonment of plans to seek approval for a four block development of office and retail space in northwest Portland; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
