Dear Carlton;

In regards to our extension of the laundry contract between the City of Portland and Industrial Laundry and Dry Cleaners, Inc., I am enclosing our proposed prices for the coming year. We particularly wish to express that this is a proposal only, and contingent upon your granting us the extension for another year as provided for in the current contract. If at all possible we would be very interested in securing an arrangement for a second year renewal if granted this extension.

We wish to raise all current laundry prices a total of 7% across the board beginning with the January 1, 1980 billing period. Again this is a proposal only and is not a firmly offered price increase. We wish to continue service with the City of Portland and I am sure that you are aware what inflation is doing to the prices of laundry service. Our best information indicates that the Portland area is currently experiencing a 14.2 % rate of inflation. In keeping with the Federal guidelines on wage and price controls we are suggesting this 7% price increase.

Our final decision in this matter can only be made after the City of Portland decides whether they will have to re-bid this contract or not.

# ORDINANCE NO. 149065

An Ordinance extending Contract No. 17678 for furnishing Industrial Clothing, Dust Mops and Shop Towels with Industrial Laundry and Dry Cleaners, Incorporated through 1980, authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- The Council finds Contract No. 17678 with Industrial Laundry and Dry Cleaners, Incorporated for furnishing Industrial Clothing, Dust Mops and Shop Towels to participating departments and bureaus of the City for a one-year period from January 1, 1979 through December 31, 1979, was awarded after a call for bids.
- Specifications call for option to renew contract for additional one (1) year period.
- 3. The Contractor, by letters dated November 12, 1979, and December 31, 1979 to the City of Portland, attached to the original only as Exhibit "A" and by this reference made a part hereof, has offered to extend said contract under the same terms and under the same conditions of the existing contract through 1980, commencing January 1, 1980.
- 4. That it is advantageous to the City to extend said contract for an additional year.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Contract No. 17678 with Industrial Laundry and Dry Cleaners, Incorporated, 4245 SE Milwaukie Avenue, Portland, OR 97202, hereby is extended through the year 1980, commencing January 1, 1980, under terms and conditions contained in said contract.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor hereby are authorized to draw and deliver warrants payable to the Contractor as set forth above, and chargeable to the appropriations of the various participating departments and bureaus using the industrial clothing, dust mops and shop towels authorized herein, when demand is presented, approved by the proper authorities.

## ORDINANCE No.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with the purchases may result in additional expenses, and will unecessarily deprive the City of the benefits of completion of the contract at an early date; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after is passage by the Council.
