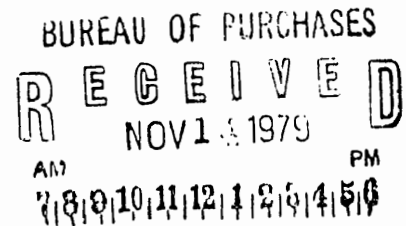


In regards to our extension of the laundry contract between the City of Portland and Industrial Laundry and Dry Cleaners, Inc., I am enclosing our proposed prices for the coming year. We particularly wish to express that this is a proposal only, and contingent upon your granting us the extension for another year as provided for in the current contract. If at all possible we would be very interested in securing an arrangement for a second year renewal if granted this extension.

We wish to raise all current laundry prices a total of 7% across the board beginning with the January 1, 1980 billing period. Again this is a proposal only and is not a firmly offered price increase. We wish to continue service with the City of Portland and I am sure that you are aware what inflation is doing to the prices of laundry service. Our best information indicates that the Portland area is currently experiencing a 14.2 % rate of inflation. In keeping with the Federal guidelines on wage and price controls we are suggesting this 7% price increase.

Our final decision in this matter can only be made after the City of Portland decides whether they will have to re-bid this contract or not.



NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:




