1. The City of Portland agrees to continue the said lease agreement through December 15, 1980 at the terms and conditions specified therein and the rates currently in effect.
2. The Datapoint Corporation agrees to continue the said lease agreement through December 15, 1980 at the terms and conditions specified therein and the rates currently in effect.
