ORDINANCE NO. 149181

An Ordinance transferring \$331,572.00 from the Fleet Operating Fund to the following funds: General, Sewage Disposal, Water, Golf, CETA, HCD, Electronic Services Operating, Central Services Operating and Insurance and Claims; and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. During FY 78-79 the Fleet Operating Fund generated a surplus of \$331,572.00 that should be returned to users in accordance with existing Council policy.
- 2. The surplus was a result of higher-than-anticipated ending FY 77-78 balance, interest earnings and equipment sales, as well as reduced expenditures.
- 3. The distribution to funds is based on total Fleet expenditures by user fund in FY 78-79. This formula has been approved by the Council in the past.
- 4. This Ordinance has been reviewed by the Bureau of Management and Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The following fund transfers be made:
