ORDINANCE No. 149182

An Ordinance authorizing a contract with Murty Brothers, pursuant to Rebid No. 70 opened January 31, 1979, for repowering one Seagrave truck for a sum of \$26.000 for the Bureau of Fleet Management, authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants, waiving performance bond and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland Ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Purchasing Agent has advertised and received proposals for repowering a Seagrave Fire truck for the Bureau of Fleet Management for assignment to the Bureau of Fire said bids being opened January 31, 1979.
- 2. Murty Brothers submitted a bid in the amount of \$26,000 and was the lowest. acceptable bidder.
- 3. This conversion project has been approved by the Council.
- 4. The Manager of the Bureau of Fleet Management recommends and the Commissioner of Public Utilities concurs, that a contract should be awarded to Murty Brothers.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- The Mayor and the Commissioner of Public Utilities hereby are authorized a. to enter into a contract with Murty Brothers, 906 N.E. 3rd Ave., Portland. Oregon 97232, for repowering a Seagrave Fire truck, for the total sum of \$26,000, said contract shall be approved as to form by the City Attorney and a performance bond requirement from the contractor hereby is waived.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor hereby are authorized to draw and deliver to Murty Brothers, 906 N.E. 3rd Ave., Portland, Oregon 97232, a warrant or warrants chargeable to the 1979-1980 Budget, Equipment (56200037/643), when demand is presented, approved by the proper authorities.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with this purchase may result in additional expenses to the City and will unnecessarily deprive the Bureau of Fire of the benefits of completion of the contract at an early date; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
