

## ORDINANCE No. 149185

An Ordinance authorizing a contract with Columbia Hydraulic Services, Inc., pursuant to Bid No. 77, opened January 29, 1980, for Six (6) Mobile Hydraulic Power Source Systems for the sum of \$27,000 for the Bureau of Fleet Management, authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants, waiving performance bond and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Purchasing Agent has advertised and received proposals for furnishing six (6) mobile hydraulic power source systems for the Bureau of Fleet Management for assignment to the Water Bureau, said bids being opened January 29, 1980.
2. Columbia Hydraulic Services, Inc., submitted a bid in the amount of \$27,000 and was the lowest bidder.
3. The Manager of the Bureau of Fleet Management recommends and the Commissioner of Public Utilities concurs, that a contract should be awarded to Columbia Hydraulic Services, Inc.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Commissioner of Public Utilities hereby are authorized to enter into a contract with Columbia Hydraulic Services, Inc., 1601 NE Columbia Blvd., Portland, Oregon 97211, for furnishing and installing six (6) Mobile Hydraulic Power Source Systems, for the total sum of \$27,000, said contract shall be approved as to form by the City Attorney and a performance bond requirement from the contractor hereby is waived.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor hereby are authorized to draw and deliver to Columbia Hydraulic Services, Inc., 1601 NE Columbia Blvd., Portland, Oregon 97211, a warrant or warrants chargeable to the 1979-1980 Budget, Equipment (56200037/643), when demand is presented, approved by the proper authorities.



The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with this purchase may result in additional expenses to the City and will unnecessarily deprive the Water Bureau of the benefits of completion of the contract at an early date; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
